


- 1 FORDNEY McCUMBER ACT = Raised American tariffs/duties/customs on imported goods in 1922
 - 2 SMOOT-HAWLEY TARIFF = Passed by president Hoover in 1930 raised customs more
 - 3 1936-1939 = Neutrality Acts - American ships were forbidden to enter war zones
 - 4 1920 = Volstead Act = NO MORE BOOZE = Forced Prohibitions
- USA ISOLATIONISM IN 1920s

PRESIDENTS


- Warren Harding 1920-24
 - Lowered immigration
 - isolationism Standpoint
- Calvin Coolidge 1924-28
 - made rest of the economic Prosperity wave
- Herbert Hoover 1928-1932 - BOO! HE'S
 - 'Chicken in Every pot'
 - 'Leizez faire'

Keynesian economic
Architect of New Deal

- ended Prohibition
 - fireside chats
- Franklin D Roosevelt 1932-1945



- 1 DAWES PLAN: In 1924 a new scheme for the Payment of reparations by which Germany paid 8% of their industrial output
- 2 YOUNG PLAN: In 1929 further reduced German War reparations by about 75%
- 3 CASH & CARRY: Britain could purchase materials from USA in the 'arsenal of democracy' (only on cash basis)
- 4 LEND LEASE: American Prez could give credit to any country whose defence is deemed vital to the defence of the USA



- 1 Huey Long - Assassinated 1932 Louisiana senator against New Deal 'share our wealth program'
- 2 Charles Coughlin - Catholic priest against the New Deal. longest regular radio audience in the world
- 3 Francis Townsend - focused on pension, appealed to elderly, formed legions. would get pension if they spend. SSA took his stuff
- 4 John Maynard Keynes - government should spend their way out of the depression. British Economist

- AAA: Agricultural Adjustment
- AAA: Control livestock/crops
- AAA: Killed some at times

NRA: National Recovery Admin

- To stabilize & improve labor conditions
- No more child labor

SSA: System of old age pensions for people over 65. THANKS SONNY

- 7 states supplied electric/Dam with Projects
- Tennessee Valley Authority

WAGNER ACT: Universal Right to negotiate. Could talk to owners about wages and working conditions

WPA: Works Progress Administration

- Cultural Projects
- Artwork
- Heavy Cons
- Municipal buildings

CCC: Civilian Conservation Corps

- Age 18-25
- pd \$30 some sent to families
- Semi military camps
- Dug canals, planted trees
