

Procedural Law

Definition - The legal processes involved in protecting our rights. Outlines the steps that happen in any legal action (ie: officer must read your charter rights after an arrest) stops police/courts from acting arbitrarily.

Example - After wrongfully arresting Ciara for no reason, Constable Fitton failed to read her the Charter of Rights and Freedom, so if she would go to court any evidence discovered/obtained during her detention might not be allowed or used against her in court.
