Sentence p.312

Punishment imposed on a person for committing a crime.

Recidivism p.313

Returning to crime after release from Prison.

Rehabilitation p.313

Punishment combined with treatment and training to help offenders in society

Restitution p.313

Punishment ~~can~~ that requires the offender to pay back the victim or society for the loss.

Retribution p.313

Punishment to avenge a crime ensuring that offenders suffer consequences of their actions

Psychiatric Assessment p.316

A report describing the mental history of the offender.

Victim Impact Statement p.316

A statement prepared by the victim or the victim's family describing the harm done or the loss suffered as a result of the offense.

Mitigating Factors p.318

Circumstances that may decrease the severity of the sentence.

Probation p.320. A sentence that allows a person to live in the community under the supervision of a parole officer.

Suspended Sentence p.320

A sentence ~~served~~ that is not carried out provided certain requirements are met.

Intermittent Sentence p.322

A sentence served on weekends and at night.

Suspension of Privilege p.324

A sentence that with holds a privilege for a certain period of time.

Incarceration p.326

Imprisonment for a specific period of time.

Parole p.339

Release of an inmate on promise of good behavior into the community before full sentence is served.

Unescorted Temporary Absence p.341

Brief release from custody for community service or personal reasons.

Pardon p.343

The setting aside of a person's record of conviction.
