


## Intro. to History of Prairies (Alberta + Saskatchewan)

- After 1871 + Passing of Manitoba Act  
series of events which led to quick  
settlement + growth of Prairie provinces.

### ① Metis Migration

- ↓ buffalo herds
- poor treatment by govt. led to Metis moving into NW territories (pd. → Alta. + Sask.)



### ② Treaties made w/ Native people

- Can. govt. formed Northwest Mounted Police who were sent to control Whiskey trade between Amca. traders + Natives — NWMP also played a key role in negotiating treaties w/ Native people.

### ③ Creation of Canadian Pacific Railway.

→ New towns + population increase occurred along new rail line.

Settlement came w/ conflict:

- ① CPR very expensive + govt scandals ~~occurred~~ occurred.
- ② Metis rebellion of 1885.

All 1st S. S. would join Canada as provinces in 1905
