

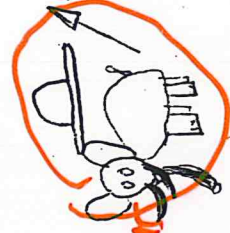
WORLD WAR I - 1914-1918

TRIGGER: STIMULUS WHICH INITIATES A REACTION

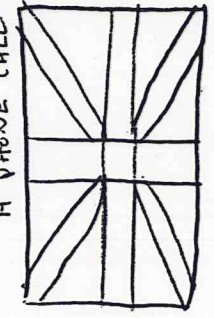
CAUSES OF WWI

- 1 IMPERIALISM: EUROPEAN COUNTRY HAS OVERSEAS COLONIES. - COMPETITION OVER THEM - CONFLICT
GERM - COLONIES
MILITARISM - MAKE YOUR ARMY STRONG. ARMY'S BUILDUP → ENGLAND - THEIR NAVY HAS TO BE BIGGEST.
- 3 ALLIANCES: DEFENSIVE
ALLIANCES FORM - IF 1 COUNTRY ATTACKS - ALL FRIENDS ATTACK. "WYME!"
- 4 NATIONALISM - ETHNIC GRPS (SERBS/SLAVS) WANTS OWN COUNTRY.

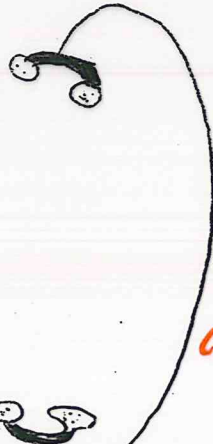
